9. Every care will be taken of the Exhibits, but Members of the Committee do not hold themselves responsible for any loss or damage.
10. The decision of the Judges shall be final.
11. Exhibits will be received in the Marquee between 8.00 a.m. and 10.00 a.m. on SATURDAY, 20th JULY, 2019.
12. **NO EXHIBITS TO BE LIFTED FROM TABLES BEFORE 3.30P.M. BUT ALL MUST BE COLLECTED BEFORE 4.00P.M.** No exhibit to be removed by stewards before 4 p.m. Please ensure you ONLY remove your own exhibits on the day of SUNDAY 21st JULY, 2019.
